The first line of the abstract should read, "Treatment of postmenopausal women with low doses of estradiol- $17\beta$  (1 mg/d) and dl-norgestrel (0.075 mg/d) significantly reduced fasting serum levels of low density lipoprotein (LDL). . . ."

The second line of Methods should read "Each experienced typical menopausal symptoms and was amenorrheic for at least 6 mo (serum follicle-stimulating hormone > 70 U/liter) before starting hormonal replacement therapy with estradiol- $17\beta$  (1 mg/d, 25 of 28 d) and dl-norgestrel (0.075 mg/d, 28 of 28 d) 4 yr earlier."
